

# Understanding and Assisting Reconciliation...

## What Reconciliation is NOT about:

- ✗ Having your own way.
- ✗ Insisting that the other party accepts your specific viewpoints.
- ✗ Rejecting outrightly the other party's viewpoints as a condition for peace making.
- ✗ Intolerance with regard to the other's viewpoint;
- ✗ Allowing your 'love and consideration' for your neighbour to be overridden by your personal doctrinal beliefs.
- ✗ Opposing or rejecting peace seeking operations in preference to your own agenda.

Reconciliation does not require rejection of your personal core beliefs, but Reconciliation requires you forbearance with opposing viewpoints which cause friction.

The issue of 'personal conviction' and insisting on 'just' your way and nothing else, in other words 'personal exclusiveness' is not really God's way. If God insisted in such a way on only HIS Way, there would be NO space for Grace and NO Hope for any of us.

LOVE surely is conditional upon accommodation of unacceptables for the sake of eventual Peaceful Restoration - as parents have to apply towards children they love, or between two spouses. It is humanly impossible to agree with each and every thing.

## What Reconciliation IS all about:

In a nutshell, it is the 'restoration of friendly, loving and caring relations'.

### Synonyms:

- ✓ reuniting, reunion, bringing (back) together (again), conciliation, reconcilment;
- ✓ pacification, appeasement, placating, propitiation, mollification;
- ✓ "the reconciliation of disputants";
- ✓ resolution, settlement, rectification;
- ✓ settling, resolving, mending, remedying;
- ✓ "a reconciliation of their differences";
- ✓ restoration of friendly relations for the sake of living together in Peace as a unit - restoration of harmony, agreement, compromise, understanding, peace, an end to hostilities, amity, concord;
- ✓ rapprochement, détente;
- ✓ harmonizing, harmonization, synthesis, squaring, adjustment, balancing;
- ✓ rare syncretisation;
- ✓ "the reconciliation opposing or conflicting viewpoints" for the sake of unity, progress and survival in Peace.

## Scholarly Definitions and 'God's Commandment' on Reconciliation:

- ✓ "Love your neighbor as yourself"

### Reconciliatory Actions in Pursuit of this Commandment:

1. the action of making one's view or belief compatible with another.  
"any possibility of reconciliation between such clearly opposed positions";  
to inspire all parties involved in conflict to accept or be resigned to something not desired: To become reconciled to one's fate while labouring for peaceful progress in restoration..
2. to win over to friendliness; cause to become amicable: to reconcile hostile persons.
3. to compose or settle (a quarrel, dispute, etc.).
4. to bring into agreement or harmony; make compatible or consistent: to reconcile differing statements.
5. to re-consecrate (a desecrated grave, building, etc.).
6. to restore (an excommunicate or exile) to its origin or roots, family, community.
7. All amounting to "Tikun Olam" - Healing of the Universe.

### Synonyms:

- ✓ pacify,
- ✓ propitiate,
- ✓ placate,
- ✓ harmonize.

### Antonyms:

- X** annoyance, irritation, antagonism, anger, resentment, hate.

### Conclusion
